



2007 Daylight Saving Time Change

How to Manually Disable DST and Update the Clock Time (Spring Edition)







This manual provides a temporary fix for the 2007 Daylight Saving Time Change. To correct the clock controller it is necessary to disable the automatic Daylight Saving Time and advance the clock ahead by 1 hour. For a permanent fix contact Electric Time Co. to schedule a service call.

USER INTERFACE

All necessary changes can be made through the user interface on the 99B-MI clock controller (shown above).

ENTER Hold for (5) seconds to access menus

Use to activate menus and make selections

CANCEL Use to cancel active menu selections

Hold for (5) seconds to exit all menus

UP / DOWN Arrows Use to scroll through menus and menu selections

LED's

- L1 / L2: Indicate which MI output line is active
- HR: Indicates status of HR output
- GPS: Indicates status of GPS (OFF: GPS not connected; Flashing: GPS found but not locked; ON: GPS locked)
 - ON: Blinks to indicate 99B-MI is on and processor is running



Disabling Daylight Saving Time

1. Hold **Enter** for (5) seconds to access menus "Time Mode:" will be displayed

Time Mode: 12 Hr

2. Press the **Up Arrow** key once, "Exit User mode" will be displayed

Exit User Mode? No

3. Press the **Enter** key once and use the **Up**Arrow key to scroll to "Enter Tech Mode"

Exit User Mode? Enter Tech Mode

4. Press the **Enter** key once and use the **Up**Arrow to scroll to "Daylight Saving: Enabled"

Daylight Saving Enabled

Press the Enter key one and the Down Arrow once, "Daylight Saving: Disabled" will be displayed.

Daylight Saving Disabled

- 6. Press the **Enter** key again to lock in the setting
- 7. If the control is not connected to a GPS receiver continue to step 8. If the control is connected to a GPS receiver use the **Up Arrow** to scroll to "Set UTC Offset:"
 - a. Press the **Enter** key twice and the **Down Arrow** once (this reduces the offset by 1 hour and sets the clock ahead)
 - b. Press the **Enter** key two more times to lock in the setting.
 - c. Use the **Up Arrow** to scroll to "Leave Tech Mode" press the **Enter** key once and scroll to "Exit All"
 - d. Press the **Enter** key once and the control will exit and the correct time will be displayed

- 8. If the control is not connected to a GPS receiver, use the **Up Arrow** key to scroll to "Leave Tech Mode?"
 - a. Press the Enter key once and use the Up Arrow key to scroll to "Enter User Mode" press the Enter key to make the selection
 - Use the **Down Arrow** to scroll to "Set Time" Press the **Enter** key once and the **Up Arrow** once to advance the time by one hour
 - c. Press the **Enter** key 3 more times to make lock in the setting and then use the **Up Arrow** key scroll to "Exit User Mode"
 - d. Press the **Enter** key once and use the **Up Arrow** to select "Yes"
 - e. Press the **Enter** key once and the control will exit and the correct time will be displayed
